Pool Update

- City voted to close 7 of 10 public pools. College Hill, Aley and Harvest will remain open
- McAdams and Edgemoor are currently the only pools closed with more closing in the following years

Pool Committee

- College Hill residents began holding fundraisers to benefit the pool in 2008 during city budget cuts in order to keep the pool open in the evening.

- Residents have continued to hold fundraisers each year since and have been able to extend the pool hours, pool season and has also purchased chairs for patrons to use.
- Currently have a little over \$2,000 in pool fund
- Would like to purchase 20 new chairs from Leslie Pools at \$210 per chair

Motion to purchase 15 chairs from Leslie Pools at \$210 using money from the pool fundraisers account and, if needed, neighborhood funds for any amount over the amount in the pool fundraiser account. Motion carried.

Roundabouts

- Circle & Terrace round about need maintenance
- Residents have started keeping up roundabouts themselves
- Circle & Bluff and English & Terrace are supposed to be cared for by the City of Wichita
- Would City of Wichita give the College Hill Neighborhood Association funds for us to take over the maintenance of these roundabouts?
- Ask local businesses if they would like to sponsor a roundabout

Neighborhood Association Membership Dues

- Need to increase dues from the current \$20 to \$30
- Dues are not mandatory
- Possibly recognize in our neighborhood newsletter those who donate above the suggested membership due amount

Treasurer's Report
