#### Roundabout Maintenance by Trish Hileman

- We have a bid for \$500 to clean up the roundabout at English and Pershing
- Will cost approximately \$150 every quarter for continued maintenance
- Motion to spend \$500 to hire out the clean-up of the roundabout at English and Pershing.
  - Discussion about the city's roll in roundabout maintenance.
  - Site obstruction would require the city to clear and maintain
  - Need to check with city to see what roll they will play
- Amendment to Motion:
  - Motion to work with Traffic Department of the City of Wichita to get the roundabout at English and Pershing trimmed within 45 days or the College Hill Neighborhood Association will pay \$500 to hire the job out. The 45 day period begins on September 20, 2017 - Motion passed
